

School of Industrial Engineering
Eligibility & Guidelines
for
Undergraduate Scholarship Applicants

Director's Undergraduate & Graduate Scholarships:

All undergraduate and graduate students enrolled in the School of Industrial Engineering who meet the eligibility requirements may be considered. At least two \$750- \$1000 scholarships, one each to an **undergraduate** and **graduate** student, paid in two installments will be awarded for the academic year.

Eligibility:

- **Undergraduate:** GPA 3.25 and U.S. citizen
- **Graduate:** GPA 3.50 and U.S. citizen

Submission material:

1. Application
2. Transcript (college)

Industrial Engineering Advisory Board Scholarship (IEAB):

All **undergraduate** students enrolled in the School of Industrial Engineering are eligible for consideration. One scholarship will be awarded for the academic year in the amount of \$750 - \$1000, paid in two installments.

Eligibility:

- **IE undergraduate** student enrolled in the School of Industrial Engineering.
- Student selected will be considered for a subsequent award as long as that student continues to make satisfactory progress toward graduation as determined by the selection committee.

Submission material:

1. Application
2. Transcript (college)
3. Resume of University activities

Industrial Engineering Scholarship:

Number of scholarships awarded varies (1-25), \$750 - \$1000 each academic year, paid in two installments.

Eligibility:

- Must be an **IE undergraduate** student (including new and/or transfer students majoring in IE) enrolled full time (12 credit hours) for each semester of the academic year except Summer semester.
- Academic merits: must have GPA 3.00.
- Leadership role in school activities, student organizations, professional societies, etc.
- Future potential in the IE profession and future professional plans.
- Financial need.

Submission material:

1. Application
2. Transcript (high school and/or college)

IE Faculty/Staff Scholarships:

At least two \$750 - \$1000 scholarships will be awarded for the academic year, paid in two installments.

Eligibility:

- Must be an **IE undergraduate** (including new freshmen and/or transfer students) or **IE graduate** student enrolled full time for each semester of the academic year except Summer semester.
- Leadership role in school activities, organizations, professional societies, etc.
- Academic merits: **undergraduate** students must have a CoE GPA 3.00 and **graduate** students must have overall GPA 3.50.
- Future potential in the IE profession and future professional plans.
- Financial need.

Submission material:

1. Application
2. Transcript (high school and/or college)
3. Resume of University activities

Bobbie Leon Foote Industrial Engineering Scholarship:

Bobbie Leon Foote has set up a trust fund to encourage and reward scholarship in Industrial Engineering. He is seeking to support an **undergraduate** student (including new incoming freshmen or transfer students) majoring in Industrial Engineering who is a high school graduate from Mayes, Craig, or Delaware counties and/or a Native American (minimum 1/4 Native American). One scholarship for the academic year will be awarded in the amount of \$750 - \$1000, paid in two installments.

Eligibility:

- **IE undergraduate** enrolled in the School of Industrial Engineering
- Student selected will be considered for a subsequent award as long as that student continues to make satisfactory progress toward graduation as determined by selection Committee.
- High School graduate of Mayes, Craig, or Delaware counties and/or a Native American (minimum 1/4 Native American)

Submission material:

1. Application
2. Transcript (high school and/or college)

George T. Gibson Scholarship:

Mr. George Gibson has set up a trust fund to encourage and reward scholarship in Industrial Engineering. He is seeking to support high GPA, IE service activities, and to aid students who work, but have been successful in course work. Up to two scholarships will be awarded in the amount of \$750 each for the academic year, paid in two installments.

Eligibility:

- Category 1: **IE Juniors** (60-89 curriculum hours) with GPA 3.00 or above
- Category 2: **IE Juniors** who work 15 or more hours per week, carrying at least 9 hours of coursework depending on workload (min. GPA 2.75)
- Category 3: **IE Seniors** (90+ curriculum hours who plan to continue on for an MS degree and have GPA 3.00 or above.

Submission material:

1. Application
 2. OU transcript
 3. Resume of University Activities
- Category 2 applicants must also include:
1. Current course enrollment
 2. Documentation of work schedule by supervisor and letter from the student indicating impact of award on the work schedule.

Global Concepts Scholarship:

Through Global Concepts a trust fund has been set up to encourage and reward scholarship in Industrial Engineering. Global Concepts is seeking to support undergraduate students with a GPA of 3.25 and above. One scholarship will be awarded for the 2006-2007 academic year in the amount of \$1000, paid in two installments.

Eligibility:

- **IE Undergraduate** students, including incoming students majoring in Industrial Engineering.
- Minimum GPA 3.25 on coursework at OU. (Incoming students must have a minimum 27 ACT score)
- Student selected on merit.

Submission material:

1. Application
2. Transcript (college/high school)

Floyd H Grant Industrial Engineering Scholarship:

Floyd H. Grant, Dugan Professor and Director of the Electromagnetic Compatibility Center has set up a scholarship fund to encourage and reward scholarship in Industrial Engineering. One scholarship in the amount of \$750- \$1000 paid in two installments.

Eligibility & Guidelines:

- **IE Undergraduate** student (including new freshman and/or transfer students **majoring in Industrial Engineering**), enrolled full time (12 credit hours) for each semester of the academic year, except Summer semester.
- Academic merits: must have GPA 3.00.
- Leadership role in school activities, student organizations, professional societies, etc.
- Future potential in the IE profession and future professional plans.
- Financial need.

Submission material:

1. Application
2. High School Transcript (if incoming freshmen)/ OU transcript

Joseph R. McClure Memorial Scholarship:

The Joseph R. McClure Memorial Scholarship has been established in honor of Joseph R. McClure, OU Industrial Engineering graduate of 1993 who died in 2005. This fund has been set up to assist a student in the School of Industrial Engineering to encourage and reward scholarship in the amount of \$1000 for the academic year, paid in two installments.

Eligibility:

- Full-time, regularly enrolled student in the School of Industrial Engineering of the University of Oklahoma.
- Maintain a 3.00 GPA on a 4.0 scale

Submission material:

1. Application
2. Transcript

Jerry L. Purswell Scholarship:

Jerry L. Purswell has set up a trust fund to encourage and reward scholarship in Industrial Engineering. He is seeking to support **undergraduate** students with a GPA 2.50 and above. One scholarship will be awarded for the academic year in the amount of \$750 - \$1000, paid in two installments.

Eligibility:

- **IE undergraduate**, including new freshmen and/or transfer students majoring in Industrial Engineering
- Minimum GPA 2.50
- Student selected will be considered for a subsequent award as long as that student continues to make satisfactory progress toward graduation as determined by the selection committee.

Submission material:

1. Application
2. Transcript (high school/college)

Earl J. Rogers Memorial Scholarship:

Steven B. Rogers, son of the late Earl J. Rogers established a scholarship fund to assist students of the University of Oklahoma School of Industrial Engineering named the *Earl J. Rogers Memorial Scholarship*. One scholarship will be awarded for the academic year in the amount of \$1000, paid in two installments.

Eligibility:

- **Undergraduate** or **graduate** student who is a resident of the State of Oklahoma.
- Full-time, regularly enrolled student in the School of Industrial Engineering of the University of Oklahoma.
- Maintain a 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale.
- Making satisfactory progress toward graduation and needs supplemental financial assistance.

- Future potential in the IE profession and future professional plans
- Financial need
